#### Uniforms

We ask that if anyone needs t-shirts or jumpers printed, hand them into the group leaders as soon as possible. At the scout meets:

Girls: light blue t-shirts (with group emblem), dark blue shors.

In colder weather: dark blue tracksuit (top with group emblem), blue jeans may be substituted for the pants.

Boys: yellow t-shirts (with group emblem), black shorts.

In colder weather: black tracksuit (top with group emblem), black jeans may be substituted for the pants.
